AUBURN RV RESORT ABBREVIATED RULES & REGULATIONS

1. **All RVers must empty their black and gray water holding tanks upon entering the Park if any chemicals other than enzyme-based or bacterial-based products are present in the tanks.** Since our sewer system utilizes an on-site septic system, the system could be severely compromised if certain chemicals such as Formaldehyde, Bronopol, Dowicil, Glutaraldehyde, Paraformaldehyde and Para-dichlorobenzene are introduced into the Park septic system. Some of the acceptable products are: RV Digest It, TST Enzyme and Eco Safe. There are certainly other products that do not contain harmful chemicals, these are simply recommendations of three products that we know to be free of harmful chemicals.
2. All RVers must sign in at the Park Management office. Check in time is 2:00 PM; check out time is 12:00 PM Noon.
3. Park only within your assigned Lot. Illegally parked vehicles may be cited and/or towed.
4. All RVs and vehicles must be kept clean, in running condition, have good paint and be in presentable condition.
5. Maximum of four (4) RVers per Lot without Management approval. and two (2) approved pets per Lot.
6. Quiet time is 9:00 PM to 8:00 AM. Please observe the 10 MPH speed limit at all times
7. You must obtain permission from Park Management to keep a pet in the Park. Pets must be on a leash or in a cage, or crate or approved pet enclosure, or within the fenced dog park areas when not inside the RV. Park Management reserves the right to assess a \$75 to \$500 per occurrence fee if you fail to clean up after your pet(s). You may be asked to leave the Park if your pet is judged to be too noisy, dangerous, or a nuisance.
8. Please keep the area around your assigned Lot neat and clean. Keep outside storage of items to a minimum.
9. No ground fires are allowed. BBQ grills cannot be used for open fires.
10. Recreational facilities are provided for the exclusive use of RVers and their accompanied guests. Children should be accompanied by an adult when not on the RVers Lot.
11. All signs, posted notices and directions of the RV Park Management must be adhered to. Non-compliance may result in immediate loss of parking privileges or eviction from the Park. All federal, state and local laws must be adhered to at all times.
12. Each RV entering the Park must be either in an acceptable condition as determined solely by Park Management and be no more than 10 years old, or an older RV in a condition approved by Park Management.
13. The Auburn RV Resort reserves the right to refuse service or evict anyone in violation of these RV Park Policies, or for destroying, or defacing property and/or creating a disturbance.
14. The Auburn RV Resort is not responsible for fire, theft, injury, or loss of personal property. RVers and all other guests of this property are liable for all property damages caused by them.
15. Smoking is prohibited at all times in the Park except for RVer's personal space.
16. Disorderly conduct, drunkenness, drugs, obscene language or rowdy behavior will not be tolerated.
17. The use or display of weapons is expressly forbidden. All weapons shall be kept in compliance with all applicable laws.
18. No fireworks of any kind are permitted on the grounds.
19. No combustible material may be stored under your RV.
20. No business or commercial activity of any nature shall be conducted at the Park.
21. Bathrooms, showers and laundry facilities are intended for use by registered RVers and their guests only. Please leave these facilities in clean condition after use. Report any non-operational or unsanitary conditions to Park Management.
22. Please be advised that our local area is home to creatures large and small. We have, including but not limited to, bears, deer, coyotes, mountain lions, foxes, skunks, racoons, and snakes including rattlesnakes. Poison Oak is also prevalent in our area.
23. Except for losses, damages or injuries for which Owner is responsible, RVer will indemnify and defend Owner, (including the owner's partners, directors, representatives, officers, employees, and agents) and the Park Management, for, from and against any and all claims, damages, liabilities, costs and expenses including, without limitation, court costs and attorney fees arising out of or related to this agreement.
24. Park Management reserves the right to make changes deemed necessary to these policies. We reserve the right to refuse service to anyone.
25. Upon RVers noncompliance with any term or condition herein, or creation of a nuisance by RVer, person residing with RV, or guests of RVer, the RVer of such violation shall be notified in writing by Park Management. If RVer fails to cure the violation within the time prescribed, Park Management shall have the right to immediately terminate this agreement and require RVer to vacate the premises.
26. Failure of RVer to vacate the premises within three days (72 hours) of the receipt of written notice of termination of this agreement will result in the RV being removed from the Park and stored at the nearest available storage area at Park Management's discretion. Failure by Park Management to act immediately upon expiration of the notice is not a waiver of any rights. Furthermore, until said RV, or vehicle is removed from the Park, RVer will be charged rent and any cost or damages caused by or incident to RVers failure to vacate the Park, including attorney's fees, cost of removal of RV/vehicle to storage facility and cost of storage.
27. One-night non-refundable deposit upon booking any reservation. This deposit will be credited towards your stay. No refunds for early departure.
28. Notice to RVers: Pursuant to California Civil Code Section 799.20, et seq., a recreational vehicle may be removed from the premises without judicial hearing, after the service of a 72- hour notice, if the occupant who has been in the park for 30 days or less, has either: (1) failed to pay for his/her occupancy in the park, or (2) failed to comply with the park's rules and regulations.
